


Breanna Edwards

As a toddler, if she was playing in another room, and music came on the television, she would run in, dance for it, and then when the music stopped, she would leave.

While she is very flexible, strength does not come naturally to her, so she works very hard, practicing daily, to build that strength, and works with her teacher to develop solo routines that will showcase her flexibility but that will also push her to show strength and power. While many other dancers around her have taken gymnastics to learn tricks, due to costs, she has not, and instead, practices using YouTube videos. She's taught herself many of her acrobatic tricks. She's still trying to master her aerial. She's very close, so we're hoping that we can have a few private gym lessons to help with that.

She joined Jr. Team five years ago and one year later was asked to become a member of the Senior Team and to dance a solo. She was 3rd runner up for her solo, Rise, during Nationals her second year on team, in the Prime division. The next year, last year, in the more advanced Youth division, she placed in the Nationals top ten for her solo, Stranger Things. This year, due to the virus outbreak, there was no nationals, but at regional competition, she earned an overall placement in the Elite Teen division, and her trio, Human, won first place overall for duos, trios, and solos in the Elite Junior division.

She has had the opportunity to participate in dance conventions such as Nuvo, training in a variety of styles with Stacey Tookey, Anthony Morigerato, Mark Meismer, Tucker Barkley, Martha Nichols, and more. She earned a scholarship for being a stand-out in tap for her determination and resolve.



Dance is her life. There is not a day that she doesn't spend at least some time dancing. She loves choreography, both learning it and creating it. She's willing to try anything, and she leaves everything on the stage. What she lacks in natural ability, she makes up for with will, hard work, and perseverance.



dancing.


After going through everything I made it back to dance just in time to march in parades with my studio and compete along side my team. Dancing has given me my best friend and a purpose in life!



Tania Daley, Samba Queen



was born in Managua, Nicaragua and grew up dancing since she was 4 years old. Tania had her first dance performance at age of 4 and at age of 6, she had her first Dance competition. She obtained first place in the category Merengue and Quebradita. Tania has an extensive dance background

such as: Afro-Caribbean, Galipso, African, Moder, Ballet, Brazilian Samba, Axe, Afro Samba, Olodum, Batucada, Soca, Punta, Salsa on1, Salsa on2, Body movement, Bachata, Cha-cha Nicaraguan Folklore, Mexican Folklore, Colombian Folklore and Flamenco. Tania's Samba History: 2001, first Batucada class, first Samba performance in Managua, Nicaragua. 2003, moved to Chicago. Tania went to a Samba event and participated in a samba competition. Took first place hosted by Chicago Samba Brazilian Band at Hot House in downtown Chicago. 2004-2009, official Samba Dancer of Passista Samba Dance Group and Planeta Azul Chicago. 2008, performance at Chicago Summer Dance in Millennium park Chicago. 2008, Took second place, winning the title of Samba Princess at the annual Chicago Samba Queen Competition hosted by Chicago Samba band in Chicago. 2010-2012, member of Folia Tropicalia Samba Group, Swing Brasileiro Band and Dill Costa troupe in Chicago. 2013, took first place at the Annual Chicago Samba Queen Competition hosted by Chicago Samba band. This time, at the top of the podium; Winning the title of Tania Daley Samba Queen. Also, hired to work and perform with the Chicago Samba band as the official Samba Queen of Chicago. 2013, Tania Daley became a Samba Soloist. Performing and teaching all over the Midwest. 2014, Tania Daley Started to work with a kids Dance Program at Latin Street Dancing teaching and coaching body movement class and basic Salsa to kids ages 6-10. Same year, she joined Jose Serrano's Dance Teams. 2015, Tania traveled to Rio de Janeiro, Brazil to participate in the Samba Parade called Carnaval. She paraded with two Samba Schools: Curicica and Unidos do Viradouro. 2016, Tania took second place in the Samba Soloist category at the World Salsa Summit in Miami. That same year, Tania was performing, competing, teaching and traveling all over the United States, Puerto Rico, Nicaragua and Canada. 2017, Tania Daley created and formed Samba Carioca Amateur Performance Team Chicago.

The team performed and competed at the Salsa congresses/Latin Dance event in the United States. 2017, Tania's work squared camera time on many latin and american television networks such as the NBC television network television series Chicago Med in Chicago. Tania trained, choreographed and taught Brazilian Samba to the actors: Yaya DaCosta, Brian Tee, Rolan Bukii. 2018, Tania competed in the same samba soloist category and won second place at the World Salsa Summit in Miami. Also, the Samba Carioca Chicago team took first place at the Latin Dance Championship hosted by Uriel and Vera (World Salsa Champions) at Bachateando event in Miami Florida. Same year, Tania and her Samba Carioca Chicago Team performed and broadcasted for WGN Chicago's very own television Chicago in Chicago. 2019, Tania Daley created instructional Samba Carioca Tutorial 1 basic dvds. In these tutorials people will learn basic samba combinations and the Samba syllabus with the Brazilian Samba rhythm combined together with fitness to lose weight, sculpt the body targeting the gluteus, quadriceps and the core muscles as Tania discovered that Brazilian Samba is an unique, incredible workout. Same year, Tania moved to New Orleans. Tania formed the Samba Carioca New Orleans Amateur Performance team in New Orleans. Same year, Tania opened up her own Dance Studio in New Orleans. Tania traveled to Brazil and participated in Carnaval in Rio de Janeiro. She was a Passista Dancer with 3 different Samba Schools. They are: Alegria da Zona Sul, Estacio de Sa and Imperio Serrano. Tania was broadcasted by Globo TV. (The National Brazilian television that broadcasts Carnaval live at the Sambadrome in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil every year. 2020, one more time Tania goes to Brazil for Carnaval.
