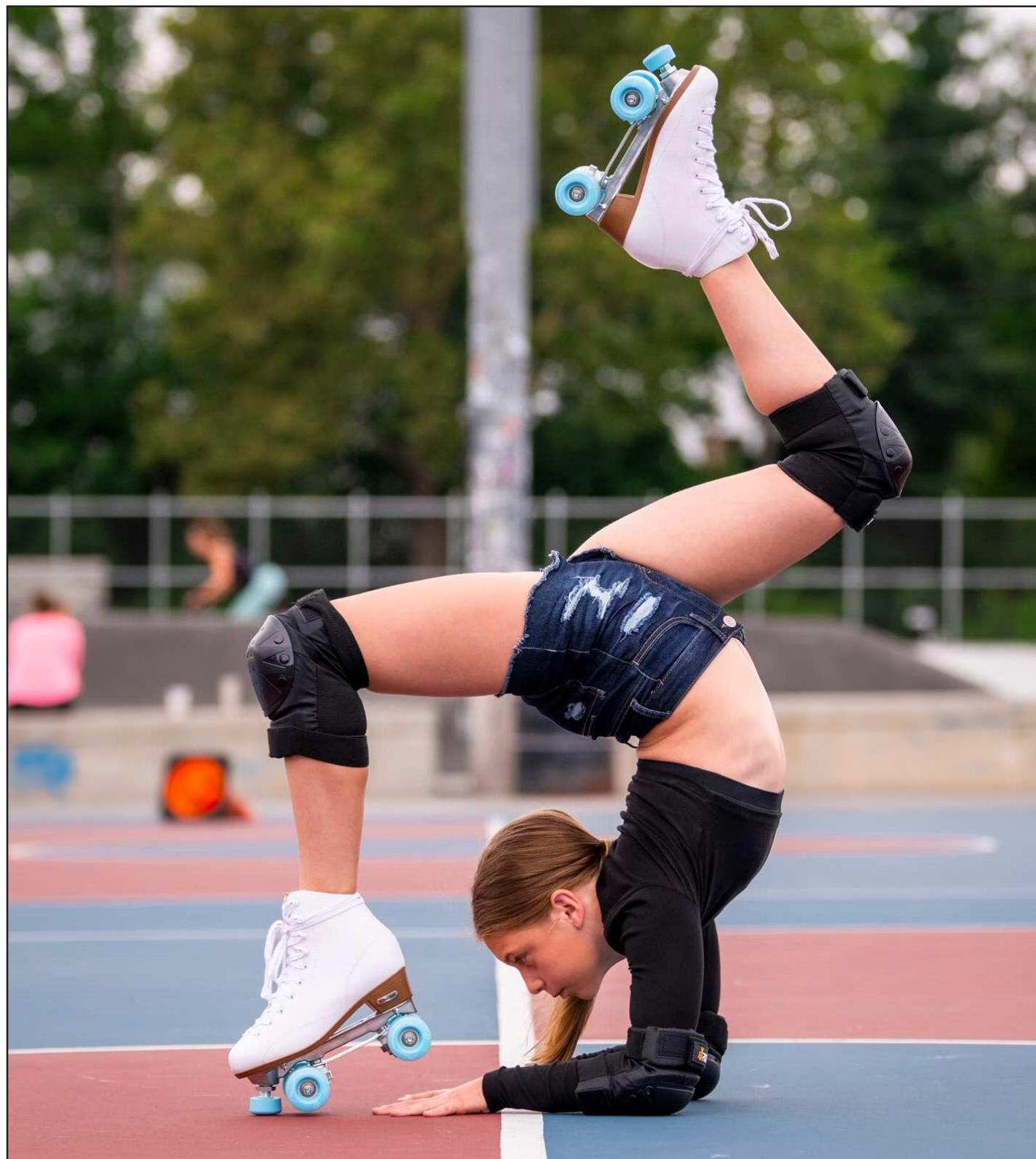
Mya Viii

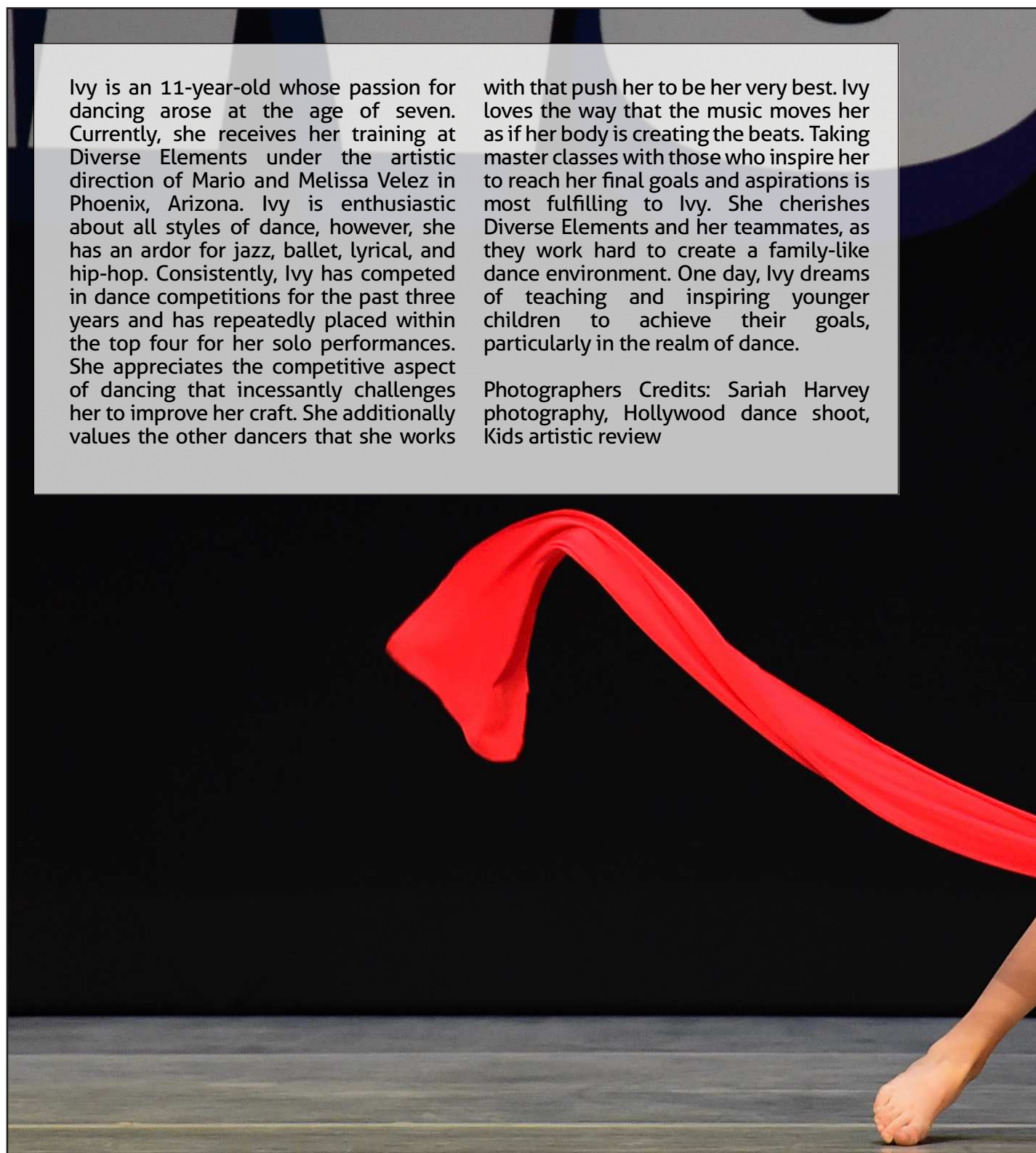


Ivy Cox

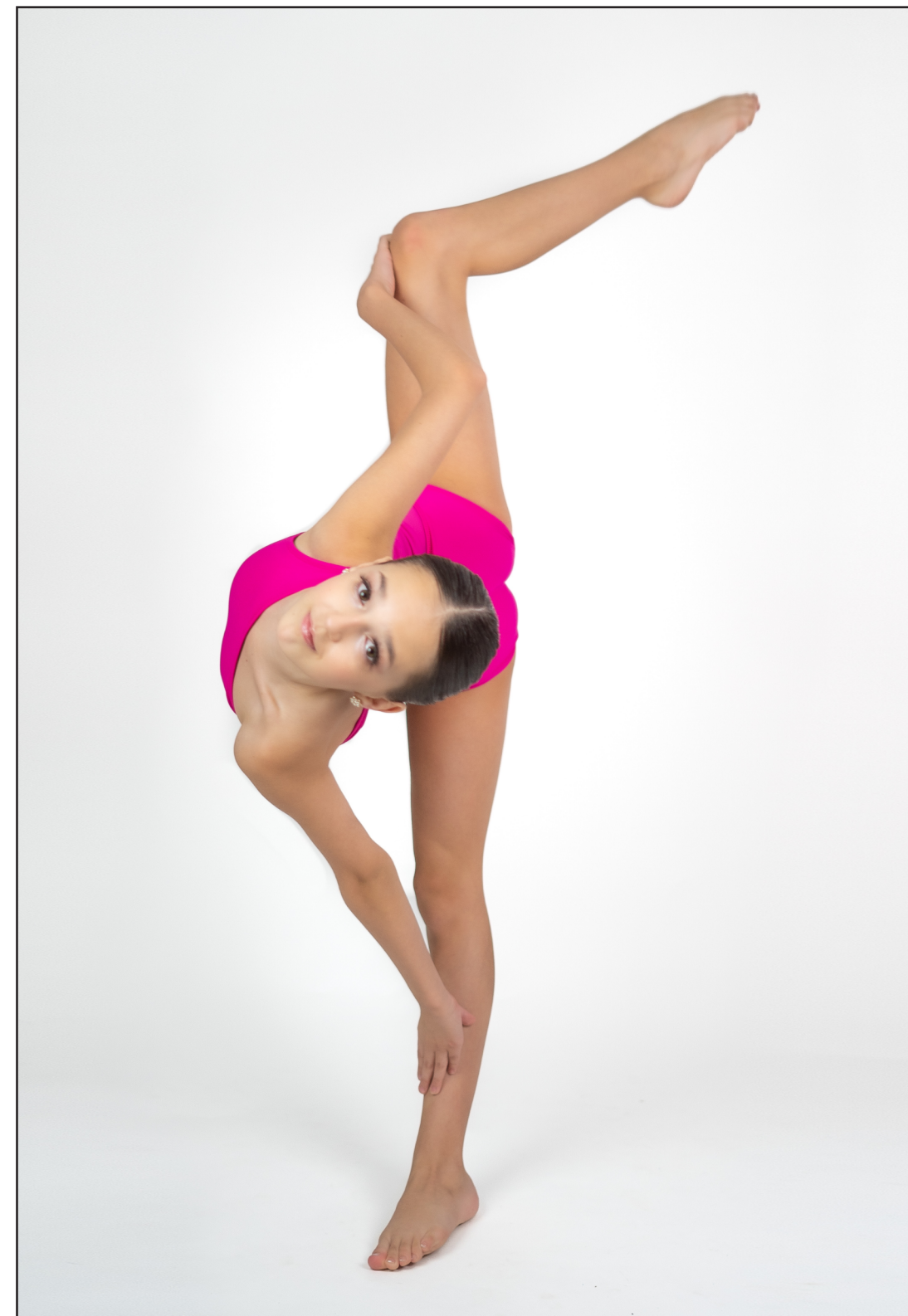
